

## Client Information Sheet:

What can I expect when I bring my pet for GatorVet Imaging services?

GatorVet Imaging is an out-patient MRI and CT imaging service offered by the Radiology Department at the Small Animal Hospital at the University of Florida.

On the day of your appointment, you will meet with the veterinary clinician who will receive and admit your pet. Drs. Amy Stone or Julia Wuerz will serve as the point of contact for clients.

This clinician will outline the imaging service goals for your pet and will ensure that the necessary information and history have been obtained.

A pre-anesthetic physical examination will be performed and immediately afterwards your pet will be transported into the GatorVet Imaging pre-anesthesia ward.

- Pets will undergo anesthesia, receive imaging and go home the same day.
- Upon discharge, you will receive a folder containing copies of essential paperwork and a CD of all images obtained through GatorVet Imaging.
- Within 48 hours, your veterinarian will receive a report from our veterinary radiologists summarizing findings from the imaging study.
